NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A LICENCE TO OPERATE AIR SERVICES

PURSUANT to the provisions of regulations 6 and 7 of the East African Licensing of Air Services Regulations 1965, notice is hereby given that Kenya Air Charters Ltd., P.O. Box 30603, Nairobi, has applied to the East African Civil Aviation Board for a licence to operate the following air service:—

Air charter and aerial work, including cabotage within Tanzania, Uganda and Kenya, based in Nairobi and Arusha with two Cessna 401, one Cessna 205 and one Piper Twin Comanche (24 passenger seats) for a period of three years.

It is further notified that any representations or objections with regard to this application must be made to the East African Civil Aviation Board at the office of the East African Common Services Organization, P.O. Box 30005, Nairobi, not later than 15th November 1967. Every such representation or objection shall be made in writing, shall state the specific grounds on which it is based, and shall specify any conditions which it may be desired should be attached to the licence if granted. A copy of every such representation or objection shall be sent by the person making the same to the applicant of the licence at the same time as it is sent to the East African Civil Aviation Board.
