ELECTIONS REGULATIONS, 1992

NOTICE OF PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 42A of the Constitution of Kenya, section 12 of the National Assembly and Presidential Elections Act and Regulations 8 and 11 of the Presidential and Parliamentary Elections Regulations, 1992, the Electoral Commission gives notice that:

- (a) An election of the President of the Republic of Kenya is to be held at the forthcoming general election.
- (b) Nomination papers for the presidential election may be delivered by the candidate personally or his/her proposer or seconder to the Electoral Commission, at Parliament Buildings, Committee Room No. 7, Parliament Road, Nairobi, between the hours of eight o'clock in the morning and one o'clock on the 14th November, 1992.
- (c) If the presidential election is contested, the poll will take place on the 7th December, 1992.

- (b) Each political party wishing to participate in the election must finalize the nomination of its candidates on or before the 11th November, 1992.
- (c) The day for the nomination for the parliamentary election will be the 13th November, 1992, and nomination papers may be delivered by candidates to the returning officer at between the hours of eight o'clock in the morning and one o'clock on the 13th November, 1992.
- (d) If parliamentary election is contested the poll will take place on the 7th December, 1992.

1. The attention of candidates and persons subscribing nomination papers is drawn to the provisions of part IV of the Presidential and Parliamentary Elections Regulations.

2. A person guilty of an election offence will be liable to the penalties imposed by the Election Offences Act (Cap. 66) and to the disqualifications imposed by the National Assembly and Presidential Elections Act.
