STAMP DUTIES ACT, 1968:
APPROVAL AND NOTIFICATION OF A NEW ISSUE
OF ADHESIVE STAMPS OF THE REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA

1. The President has under the Stamp Duties Act, 1968 (Act 77 of 1968), approved the issue of adhesive revenue and penalty stamps of the following denominations for use under the said Act with effect from 1 June 1990:

Revenue stamps: 5c, 10c, 20c, 50c, R1, R2, R5, R10, R20, R50, R100, R200, R500 and R1 000.

Penalty stamps: 5c, 10c, 20c, 50c, R1, R2, R5, R10, R20, R50 and R100.

2. The stamps of the issue referred to in paragraph 1 -
 - (a) shall, subject to the provisions of any regulations made under section 33 of the said Act, substitute the stamps of the issue referred to in Government Notice R. 1133 of 2 June 1978 of the Republic of South Africa; and
 - (b) are of a new design, depicting a map of the Republic of Namibia and will bear the words "Namibia Revenue" instead of the letters "RSA" which appear on the stamps of the issue referred to in the said Government Notice of the Republic of South Africa.

STAMP DUTIES ACT, 1968:
REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE DEMONETIZATION
AND WITHDRAWAL OF A PARTICULAR ISSUE
OF STAMPS

The President has under section 33 of the Stamp Duties Act, 1968 (Act 77 of 1968), made the regulations set out in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

1. Subject to the provisions of section 32 (1) (d) of the said Act and regulation 2, the issue of adhesive revenue and penalty stamps referred to

in Government Notice R. 1133 of 2 June 1978 of the Republic of South Africa shall be regarded as demonetized and withdrawn with effect from 21 June 1990.

2. The provisions of regulation 1 shall not apply to revenue or penalty stamps overprinted for special purposes, including for the purpose of consular service.
3. The regulations promulgated under Government Notice R. 1132 of 2 June 1978 of the Republic of South Africa, are hereby repealed.
