#### LEVY ON WOOL UNDER THE KARAKUL PELTS AND WOOL ACT, 1982 (ACT 14 of 1982)

Under the powers vested in me by section 18 of the Karakul Pelts and Wool Act, 1982 (Act 14 of 1982), and on recommendation of the Karakul Board of Namibia, I hereby impose a levy and a special levy on wool as set out in the Schedule.

## SCHEDULE

1. In this notice, unless the context otherwise indicates, any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Karakul Pelts and Wool Act, 1982, shall have a corresponding meaning.

2. A levy is herewith imposed on -

- (a) wool which is sold at an auction through the Board or an agent of the Board; and
- (b) wool on unprocessed skins received by a processor in Namibia and removed from the skins for processing of the skins or such wool.

3. A special levy is herewith imposed on wool which is sold at an auction through the Board or an agent of the Board.

4. (1) The amount of the levy imposed by -

- (a) subparagraph (a) of paragraph 2 is 7,5 per cent of the gross realization of the wool; and
- (b) subparagraph (b) of paragraph 2 is 5,965 cents per kilogram.

(2) The amount of the special levy imposed by paragraph 3 is 5 per cent of the gross realization of the wool concerned.

5. (1) The special levy referred to in paragraph 2 is imposed to defray the expenditure which the Board or the agent may incur in connection with the selling and promotion in Namibia and elsewhere of wool.

(2) The special levy referred to in paragraph 3 is imposed to generate the funds necessary for the stabilisation of sale prices of wool at auctions.

6. (1) The levy imposed by -

- (a) subparagraph (a) of paragraph 2 shall be payable to the Board at the time when the wool is delivered to the Board for sale and may be recovered by the Board or an agent of the Board by deducting the amount of the levy from the amount of any advance payable in respect of that wool under section 12 of the Karakul Pelts and Wool Act, 1982;
- (b) subparagraph (b) of paragraph (2) shall be payable by the processor by whom the unprocessed skins were received before or on the last day of the month following the month in which the skins were received.

(2) The special levy imposed by paragraph 3 may be recovered by the Board or an agent of the Board by deducting the amount of the levy from the amount of any distribution in respect of the said wool under section 12 of the said Karakul Pelts and Wool Act, 1982.
