AMENDMENT OF GOVERNMENT NOTICE 14 OF 1995

Government Notice 14 of 30 January 1995 is hereby amended by the substitution for the date "30th February 1995" of the date "28 April 1995".

PENSION FUNDS ACT, 1956: AMENDMENT OF REGULATIONS

The Minister of Finance has under section 36 of the Pension Funds Act, 1956 (Act 24 of 1956), made the regulations set out in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

1. In these regulations "the Regulations" means the Regulations promulgated by Government Notice R.98 of 1962, as amended by Government Notices R.2144 of 1984, R.1790 of 1985, R.1037 of 1986, R.232 of 1987, R.1452 of 1989, 103 of 1994 and 143 of 1994.
2. Regulation 28 of the Regulations is hereby amended -
 - (a) by the substitution for subregulation (2) of the following subregulation:

“(2) Subject to the provisions of this regulation, a fund may invest only in assets set out in column 1 of the Annexure to the extent that the market value of the investment in any such asset, expressed as a percentage of the market value of the total assets of the fund, does not exceed the percentage set out in column 2 of the Annexure in respect of such asset: Provided that -

 - (a) the aggregate of the market value of investments in assets referred to in items 5 and 6 in column 1 of the Annexure, expressed as a percentage, shall not exceed 90%;

- (b) the aggregate of the market value of investments in assets referred to in items 5, 6, 7 and 8(e) in column 1 of the Annexure, expressed as a percentage, shall not exceed 95%,

of the market value of the total assets of the fund.”;

- (b) by the substitution for subregulation (5) of the following subregulation:

“(5) Notwithstanding subregulation (2), no fund shall with effect from -

(a) 31 December 1994, invest more than 85%;

(b) 31 March 1995, invest more than 75%;

(c) 30 June 1995, invest more than 65%,

of the market value of its total assets outside Namibia: Provided that assets consisting of shares acquired in a company incorporated outside Namibia shall for the purposes of this subregulation be regarded as assets invested in Namibia if such shares have been acquired on the Namibian Stock Exchange.”;

- (c) by the insertion of the following subregulation after subregulation (5):

“(5A) (a) Every fund shall within six months after the end of each financial year, furnish the registrar with a return in such form as he or she may prescribe which shall contain such particulars as he or she may require in order to determine whether the fund is complying with subregulation (2).

(b) Every fund shall within 30 days after each date referred to in paragraphs (b) and (c) of subregulation (5), furnish the registrar with a return in such form as he or she may prescribe which shall contain such particulars as he or she may require in order to determine whether the fund is complying with that subregulation.”.
