#### INVITATION FOR REPRESENTATIONS ON PROHIBITION OF USE OF CERTAIN MARK AND WORDS: MEAT BOARD OF NAMIBIA: MERCHANDISE MARKS ACT, 1941

In terms of section 13 of the Merchandise Marks Act, 1941 (Act No. 17 of 1941), I invite -

- (a) persons interested in the request made by the Meat Board of Namibia for the prohibition under section 15(1) of that Act of the use by any person, other than the Meat Board of Namibia or without the consent of the Meat Board of Namibia, of the -
- (i) mark set out in the Schedule; and
  - (ii) words “farm, assured, namibian, meat” and devices of the Namibian map outline with two cattle if they are used together with the mark contemplated in subparagraph (i),

in connection with any trade, business profession or occupation or in connection with a trade mark, mark or trade description applied to goods; and

- (b) persons interested in the matter under paragraph (a) to submit, in writing, any representations which they intend to make on the matter to the Director of Commerce: Ministry of Industrialisation, Trade and SME Development, corner of Goethe and Dr. Kenneth Kaunba Streets, Brendan Simbwaye Square, Block B, Second Floor, Windhoek, to reach the Director within 60 days from the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*, or sending the written representations by mail to the Director of Commerce: Ministry of Industrialisation, Trade and SME Development, Private Bag 13340, to reach the Director within 60 days from the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*.
