- a) The Authority resolved to extend the temporary spectrum licence awarded to **Mobile Telecommunications Limited** on 11 April 2020 until 20 August 2020 as set out below:

- ii) 3316 - 3350 MHz (Downlink) with bandwidth of 34 MHz.
