MINERALS ACT (CHAPTER 121)

Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition (Amendment)
(No. 2) Declaration, 1964

Commencement: 18th June, 1964

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 of the Minerals Act and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following declaration—

1. This Declaration may be cited as the Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition (Amendment) (No. 2) Declaration 1964 and shall apply throughout the Federation.

2. Immediately after paragraph 42 of the Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition Declaration 1946, there shall be inserted the following new paragraphs:—

“43. The following area is hereby declared to be closed to prospecting for all minerals:—

All that parcel of land known as MRA.44 (major portion of Late ML 11507), in the Jos Division of Plateau Province, containing an area of approximately 170.4 acres, the boundaries of which are described as follows, that is to say—

Starting at a concrete pillar, marked LM, MRA.44, the Colony Co-ordinates of which are:—

**Nigerian Industrial Development Bank Limited
(Exemption) Order, 1964**

Commencement : 18th June, 1964

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 2A of the Moneylenders Act as amended by the Moneylenders (Amendment) Act, 1960 and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Order—

1. This Order may be cited as the Nigerian Industrial Development Bank Limited (Exemption) Order, 1964 and shall apply to the Federal Territory only.

2. The Nigerian Industrial Development Bank Limited, a body corporate whose registered office is at Development House, Labinjo Lane, Lagos, shall be exempted from the provisions of the Moneylenders Act.

3. The Investment Company of Nigeria Limited (Exemption) Order, 1960 is hereby revoked.

Commonwealth Development Corporation (Exemption) Order, 1964

Commencement : 1st October, 1960

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 2A of the Moneylenders Act as amended by the Moneylenders (Amendment) Act, 1960, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Order

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Commonwealth Development Corporation (Exemption) Order, 1964 and shall apply to the Federal Territory only.

(2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into effect from 1st October, 1960.

2. The Commonwealth Development Corporation a body corporate established under an Act of Parliament of the United Kingdom, which has its principal place of business in Nigeria at 5 Customs Street, Lagos shall be exempted from the provisions of the Moneylenders Act.
