FIREARMS ACT (CHAPTER 69)

Firearms Prohibition (Mid-Western Nigeria) Order, 1964

Commencement : 31st December, 1964

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 36 of the Firearms Act and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf I hereby make the following Order : -

1. This Order may be cited as the Firearms Prohibition (Mid-Western Nigeria) Order, 1964, and shall apply only to Mid-Western Nigeria.

Citation and application.

2. The possession of or dealing in any firearms or ammunition in the Irrua-Ewa District Council area and in the Ewohimi-Ewatto-Ewossa District Council area in the Ishan Division of Benin Province in Mid-Western Nigeria, is hereby prohibited for a period of three months from the date of publication of this Order.

Prohibition.

3. All firearms and ammunition in possession of any person within the area specified in the foregoing paragraph 2 of this Order shall be surrendered forthwith to the Divisional Police Officer, Ishan Division, Ubiaja.

Surrender.
