IMMIGRATION ACT 1963  
(1963, No. 6)**Momodu Bamugho Deportation Order 1966**

WHEREAS on the 9th day of September 1965 MOMODU BAMUGHO was convicted of offences under sections 17 (1) (a) and 17 (1) (f) (i) of the Immigration Act 1963 at the Magistrate's Court, Ogoja:

AND WHEREAS the said Court in exercise of the powers conferred by section 47 of the Immigration Act 1963, recommended that the said MOMODU BAMUGHO be deported from Nigeria:

AND WHEREAS THE Federal Executive Council, after considering the recommendation aforesaid, is satisfied that it is in the public interest that a deportation order be made:

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 (1) of the Immigration Act 1963 (as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree, 1966) the Federal Executive Council has ordered that the said MOMODU BAMUGHO, upon the expiration of any sentence of imprisonment which he is now serving, and at the first available opportunity, shall leave Nigeria and thereafter remain out of Nigeria.
