A BILL

FOR

AN ACT TO AUTHORISE THE ISSUE OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED REVENUE FUND OF THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY POUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING FURTHER PROVISION FOR THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING ON 31ST MARCH 1966 AND TO APPROPRIATE THAT AMOUNT FOR THE PURPOSES SPECIFIED IN THIS ACT.

Commence-
ment.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislature of the Federation of Nigeria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The total of the amounts mentioned in section 1 of the Appropriation Act 1965 and section 1 of the Supplementary Appropriation (1965-66) Act 1965 (which together provide for the issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund in respect of the year ending on 31st March 1966 of sums not exceeding in aggregate £86,837,690 shall be increased by two hundred and seventy-seven thousand three hundred and seventy pounds; and the additional amount shall be appropriated to heads of expenditure as indicated in the Schedule of this Act.

Issue and appropriation of £277,370 from Consolidated Revenue Fund for service of 1965-66. 1965 Nos. 13 and 33.

2. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1965-66) (No. 2) Act 1966 and shall apply throughout the Federation.
