In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Imports Prohibition Order, 1959 and all other powers enabling him in that behalf the Import Licensing Authority has made the following Notice :—

1. The Open General Import Licence (Wheat and Wheat Flour) No. 1 of 1962 is amended by the deletion therefrom of item (ii) of paragraph 2; *viz*

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of the Notice is that a specific import licence is now required for the importation of wheat flour into Nigeria from all countries, while Wheat and Spelt (including Meslin) unmilled can be imported freely.
