FEDERAL HIGHWAYS DECREE 1971

(1971 No. 4)

Federal Highways (Delegation of Powers) Order 1975

Commencement: 25th February 1975

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 19 (9) of the Federal Highways Decree 1971 (as amended by the Federal Highways Decree 1973), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, Brigadier Olusegun Obasanjo, the Federal Commissioner for Works and Housing, hereby make the following Order :—

1. The powers conferred on the Director under section 19 of the Federal Highways Decree 1971 is hereby delegated to and may be exercised in any State in the Federation by that State's director of public works, so however that nothing in the foregoing delegation shall prevent the exercise by the Director of Federal Public Works himself of any of the powers so delegated.

2. This Order may be cited as the Federal Highways (Delegation of Powers) Order 1975.
