Raphael Manfred Lehmann Deportation Order 1977

Commencement : 9th March 1977

I, the Federal Commissioner for Internal Affairs, being of opinion that Raphael Manfred Lehmann at present in Nigeria ought to be classified as a prohibited immigrant and acting under the powers conferred by section 18 (3) of the Immigration Act 1963, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, accordingly order that the said Raphael Manfred Lehmann shall be deported from Nigeria by the first available means and I direct that the said Raphael Manfred Lehmann shall thereafter remain out of Nigeria.

This Order may be cited as the Raphael Manfred Lehmann Deportation Order 1977.

PORTS ACT
(CAP. 155)

Ports (Piers) (Amendment) Regulations 1977

Commencement : 9th March 1977

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 42F of the Ports Act, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Nigerian Ports Authority hereby makes the following regulations :—

1. Regulation 18 of the Ports (Piers) Regulations 1968 is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after paragraph (2) thereof of a colon in substitution for the fullstop and of the following proviso, that is to say :—

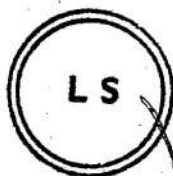

“Provided that no such fees shall be payable by the owner or occupier of a pier where the pier has been constructed and is being maintained by the said owner or occupier in an area where the Nigerian Ports Authority does not have its own wharf which could have been used by the said owner or occupier.”

2. These regulations may be cited as the Ports (Piers) (Amendment) Regulations 1977.
