LABOUR DECREE 1974  
(1974 No. 21)  
**Labour Decree (Trade Union Contributions)  
Order 1977**

*Commencement : 22nd February 1977*

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 5 (3) of the Labour Decree 1974, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, Major-General Henry Edmund Olufemi Adefope, Federal Commissioner for Labour, hereby make the following order :—

1. The trade union specified in the Schedule hereto is hereby approved for the purposes of section 5 (3) of the Labour Decree 1974 with effect from the date specified in the second column of the Schedule.

2. This order may be cited as the Labour Decree (Trade Union Contributions) Order 1977.
