AN ACT TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE NUMBER OF PERSONS TO CONSTITUTE MEMBERSHIP OF THE NATIONAL DOCK LABOUR BOARD.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federation
2 of Nigeria and by authority of same as follows :—

3 1. For subsection (1) of section 2 of the National Dock Labour Decree
4 1979, there shall be substituted the following new subsection, that is—

5 “(1) The Board shall consist of a Chairman to be appointed by the
6 President and the following other members, that is—

7 (a) five persons to be appointed by the President ;

8 (b) one person to represent registered dock labour employers ;

11 (d) two persons to represent dock workers ;

12 (e) one person to represent shipping companies.”

13 2. This Act may be cited as the National Dock Labour (Amend-
14 ment) Act 1980.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The Federal Government has decided to reconstitute the membership of the board of directors of the National Dock Labour Board by reducing official representation thereon and at the same time increasing the number of non-*ex-officio* members.

Accordingly, the proposed membership in this Bill is as follows—

- (a) a chairman to be appointed by the President ;
- (b) five persons to be appointed by the President ;
- (c) two persons to represent registered dock labour employers ;
- (d) the General Manager of the National Cargo Handling Company;
- (e) two persons to represent dock workers ;
- (f) one person to represent shipping companies.
