1 BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal
2 Republic of Nigeria as follows—

3 1. The National Youth Service Corps Act 1973 is hereby amended
4 by *substituting* for section 2 thereof the following new section—

5 "Calling up
of members
of Corps. 2.—(1) Subject to the provisions of this Act every Nige-
6 rian up to the age of 30 years, shall—

7 (a) if, at the end of the 1972-73 academic year or as the
8 case may be at the end of any subsequent academic year,
9 he shall have graduated at any university in Nigeria ; or

10 (b) if, at the end of the 1974-75 academic year or as the
11 case may be at the end of any subsequent academic year,
12 he shall have graduated at any university outside Nigeria ;
13 or

14 (c) if, at the end of the 1975-76 academic year or as the
15 case may be at the end of any subsequent academic year,
16 he shall have obtained the Higher National Diploma or
17 the National Certificate of Education or such other
18 professional qualification as may be prescribed ;

1 be under an obligation unless exempted under section 15 of
2 this Act to make himself available for service for a conti-
3 nuous period of one year from the date specified in the
4 call-up instrument served upon him.

5 (2) A person liable to be called-up to serve in the service
6 corps shall serve for a continuous period of one year as
7 from the date specified in the call-up instrument served
8 upon him or, as the case may be, if a general or special
9 notice to that effect is given in the prescribed manner ; and
10 when so called upon such person shall make himself
11 available for service and shall present himself at such place
12 and time and to such person or authority as may be specified
13 in the instrument or notice.

14 (3) The President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria
15 may, by Order published in the Gazette, extend the
16 application of the provisions of subsection (1) of this section
17 to other categories of Nigerians who shall have obtained
18 such diplomas, certificates or other qualifications as may be
19 prescribed in the Order, from universities, colleges and other
20 institutions of higher learning within or outside Nigeria,
21 and the Order may specify different dates for call-up in
22 relation to different categories of those affected or to be
23 affected by the Order."

24 2. This Act may be cited as the National Youth Service Corps
25 (Amendment) Act 1983.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to exempt all persons above the age of 30 years; from being called-up for the national youth service.

10 Account, etc.) (Amendment) Act 1983.
