**FEDERAL GOVERNMENT OF NIGERIA SUKUK SPECIAL
PURPOSE VEHICLE EXEMPTION ORDER, 2017**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Section 309 of the Investments and Securities Act No. 29 of 2007 and all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, KEMI ADEOSUN (MRS), Honourable Minister of Finance, Federal Republic of Nigeria hereby make the following Order—

1. That the requirements for approval of primary issuance as set out in Part XV of the Investments and Securities Act, 2007 and all rules and regulations made pursuant thereto shall not apply to all Special Purpose Vehicles or Companies incorporated for the sole purpose of issuing Sukuk on behalf of the Federal Government of Nigeria, provided that where the securities are to be traded on a securities exchange or capital trade point, they shall be subject to the regulatory requirements relating to secondary market transactions.
