LEGAL NOTICE NO. 56 OF 1979

THE DAIRY ACT, 1968

(Act No. 28 of 1968)

THE FIXATION OF LIQUID MILK PRICES REGULATIONS, 1979

(Under section 24)

(Commencement: 1st July, 1979)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 24 of the Dairy Act, 1968, the Minister for Agriculture and Co-operatives, after consultation with the Swaziland Dairy Board hereby makes the following Regulations —

*Citation and commencement.*

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fixation of Liquid Milk Prices, 1979 and shall come into force on the 1st July, 1979

*Minimum price to be paid to a producer of milk.*

2. The price to be paid by a milk processor to a milk producer for fresh milk delivered by him to such processor shall be not less than 18 cents a litre.

*Maximum price to be paid to a milk processor by a milk purveyor.*

3. The price to be paid by a milk purveyor of liquid milk for fresh milk delivered to him by a processor shall be 36 cents per litre for packaged milk or 34 cents per litre for bulk milk.

*Maximum selling price of liquid fresh milk.*

4. The maximum selling price of liquid milk for fresh milk by dairies, milk shops and milk purveyors to the public shall be 38 cents per litre for cartoned milk.

*Maximum price to be paid to a milk processor of cultured milk (Emasi) by a milk purveyor.*

5. The price to be paid by a milk purveyor of cultured milk (Emasi) delivered to him by a processor shall be 30 cents per litre for packaged emasi.

*Maximum selling price of cultured milk Emasi.*

6. The maximum selling price of cultured milk (Emasi) by dairies, milk shops and milk purveyors to the public shall be 32 cents per litre for cartoned emasi and 30 cents per litre for bulk emasi.

*Revocation of Legal Notice No. 2 of 1972.*

7. The Fixation of Liquid Milk Prices Regulations 1972 (Legal Notice No. 2 of 1972) is hereby revoked.

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 57 OF 1979

THE DAIRY ACT, 1968

(Act No. 28 of 1968)

THE FIXATION OF POWDERED MILK AND ALLIED  
PRODUCTS PRICES (NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 1979

(Under section 24)

(Date of Commencement: 29th June, 1979)

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by the abovementioned Act and on the recommendation of the Swaziland Dairy Board, the Honourable the Minister for Agriculture and Co-operatives is pleased to make the following regulations:—

*Citation and commencement.*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Fixation of Powdered Milk and Allied Products Prices Regulations 1979 and shall come into force on the 29th June, 1979.

*Maximum Wholesale and Retail Selling Prices.*

2. The maximum wholesale and retail selling prices of powdered milk and allied products in Swaziland shall be as set out in the Schedule to this Notice.

*Revocation of Legal Notice No. 30 of 1979.*

3. The Fixation of Powdered Milk and Allied Products Prices Regulations 1979 (Legal Notice No. 30 of 1979) are hereby revoked.
