**REGENT'S DECREE NO.4 OF 1984**  
**THE KING'S PROCLAMATION (AMENDMENT) (NO.3) DECREE,**  
 1984

In exercise of the powers vested in me and in accordance with paragraph 14 of the King's Proclamation to the Nation of the 12th April, 1973, I Ntombi, Ndlovukazi and Regent of the Kingdom of Swaziland, hereby make the following Decree -

**Short Title**

1. This Decree may be cited as the King's Proclamation (Amendment) (No. 3) Decree, 1984 and shall be read as one with the King's Proclamation to the Nation of the 12th April, 1973.

**Amendment of Proclamation**

2. Paragraph 10 of the King's Proclamation to the Nation of the 12th April, 1973 is amended by replacing sub-paragraph (2) (b) with the following -

“(b) The definition “Liqoqo” is replaced with the following:-

“Liqoqo” means the Supreme Council of State whose function is to advise the King on all matters of State and which shall -

- (i) consist of members appointed by the King to hold office at his pleasure and in accordance with such terms and conditions (including emoluments and allowances) as he may determine;
- (ii) be immune from suit and legal process in any civil cause in respect of all things done or omitted to be done by it or any member thereof in the exercise of its functions,

Provided that no person shall be qualified to be a member solely by virtue of his holding another office whether or not such office is established by law;”

This Decree shall be deemed to have come into effect from the 1st day of March, 1984.
