AN ACT
entitled

An Act to provide for the appropriation of a certain sum of money for the financial year commencing on 1st April, 1991 and ending on 31st March, 1992.

ENACTED by the King and the Parliament of Swaziland.

Short title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (1991/92) Act, 1991 and shall be deemed to have come into force on 1st April, 1991.

Charge to Consolidation Fund.

2. The Consolidation Fund is charged with such sum of money not exceeding in the aggregate eight hundred and sixteen million five hundred and twenty-three thousand Emalangeni (E816,523,000) as required for the services of the Government of the Kingdom of Swaziland during the financial year commencing on 1st April, 1991 and ending on 31st March, 1992.

Application of sum appropriated.

3. The sum appropriated by section 2 shall be applied to the services set out in the first column of the Schedule to this Act and in the respective amount appearing on the second and third columns in respect of each service.
