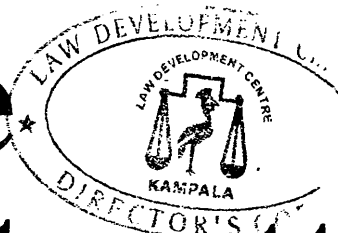

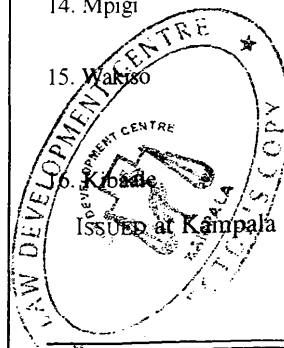

CHANGE OF NAME - DEED POLL DECLARATION

I, Alfred Omony - Ogaba of Puranga, Parwec, Puranga Sub-County, Aruu County, Pader District, do solemnly and sincerely declare as follows that:

1. I am a Ugandan national, and citizen by birth and descent.
2. I was born on the 15th day of September 1947, at Puranga Parwec in the then Acholi District, but now in Puranga Sub-County, Aruu County, Pader District.
3. I was named Omony, and baptized Alfred.
4. At school, I adopted the use of the Christian name Abuneri, it being my father's Christian name, and abandoned the use of my Christian name Alfred.
5. Later, at school still, I added my father's surname "Ogaba" to mine, thereby resulting in my school and academic records and testimonials bearing either the name Abuneri Omony, or Abuneri Omony Ogaba. Both names referred to me, but nobody else.
6. In the year 1972, I reverted to the use of my Christian name "Alfred", and also retained my father's name "Ogaba", and thereby I became known, and have since been known, called, addressed, referred to, or identified, as ALFRED OMONY OGABA to this day.
7. I make this declaration, in support of the "Change of Name - Deed Poll" I have executed to formalize the change of name I made in 1972 as aforesaid.

AND I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true.
