Apply appropriate accounting, and budget controls more efficiently and effectively.

Provide up to date information for budgeting and monitoring.

(iv) Provide real time information for economic planning and management.

(v) Provide timely and reliable financial reports to Parliament, Government and the citizens of Uganda.

#### 2. Accounting Units

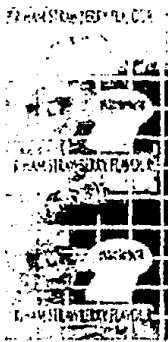

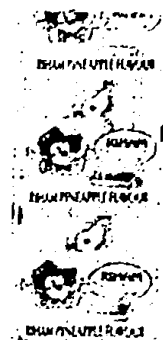

**The Public Enterprises Reform and Divestiture  
(Vesting of Undertaking of Uganda Electricity Board)  
Instrument, 2004.**

*(Under section 29 (1) of the Public Enterprises Reform and  
Divestiture Act, Cap 98).*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for the reform and divestiture of public enterprises by section 29(1) of the Public Enterprises Reform and Divestiture Act, this Instrument is made this 11th day of August 2004.

1. This Instrument may be cited as the Public Enterprises Reform and Divestiture (Vesting of Undertaking of Uganda Electricity Board) Instrument, 2004 and shall be deemed to have come into force on 31st July 2004.

2. (1) The 31st day of July 2004 is appointed to be the date on which the undertaking of Uganda Electricity Board specified in the First and Second Schedules shall be deemed to have been vested in its successor companies, Uganda Electricity Distribution Company Limited and Uganda Electricity Transmission Company Limited, in the following manner –

- (a) the assets specified in the First Schedule which, before the commencement of this Instrument belonged to Uganda Electricity Board are transferred to the Uganda Electricity Distribution Company Limited;



(b) the assets specified in the Second Schedule, which, before the commencement of this Instrument belonged to Uganda Electricity Board, are transferred to the Uganda Electricity Transmission Company Limited.

(2) Notwithstanding the transfer to the Uganda Electricity Transmission Company Limited of the assets specified in the Second Schedule, the Uganda Electricity Distribution Company Limited shall have access rights to those assets without further authority than this instrument.

3. For the avoidance of doubt, the undertaking of Uganda Electricity Board not vested in a successor company by this Instrument or by any other instrument made under section 29(1) of the Public Enterprises Reform and Divestiture Act, shall, until otherwise dealt with by law, continue to be vested in the Uganda Electricity Board.
