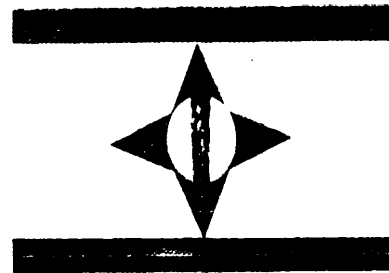

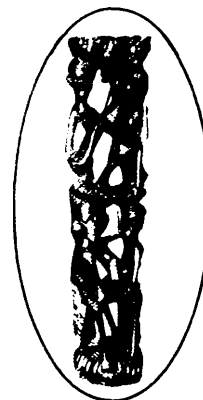

The family life tree represents our Motto Together We Develop, Transform and Grow.

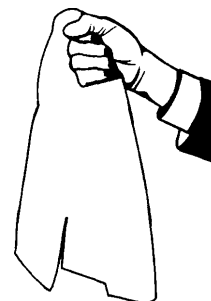
The White colour represents clean politics, Green represents Ever green nature of our country (Environment) and Golden Yellow to represent development by adding value.

The Electoral Commission (Appointment of Date of Completion of Update of Voters' Register in Ntoroko County Constituency, Bundibugyo District) Instrument, 2007.

(Under Section 19(8)(b) of the Electoral Commission Act, Cap 140).

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister under section 19(8)(b) of the Electoral Commission Act, Cap 140, this Instrument is made this 23rd day of July, 2007.

1. Title.

This Instrument may be cited as the Electoral Commission (Appointment of Date of Completion of Update of Voters' Register in Ntoroko County Constituency, Bundibugyo District) Instrument, 2007.

2. Appointment of completion date.

The 24th day of July, 2007, is hereby appointed as the date upon which the Commission shall complete the exercise of updating the Voters' Register for purposes of the by-election in Ntoroko County Constituency, Bundibugyo District.
