DECLARATION AS AN APPROVED TOWNSHIP**

In terms of section 103 of the Town Planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986 (Ordinance 15 of 1986), the Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality, Kempton Park Customer Care Centre hereby declares BREDELL EXTENSION 20 township to be an approved township subject to the conditions set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

STATEMENT OF THE CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THE APPLICATION MADE BY MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES PENSION FUND (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE APPLICANT / TOWNSHIP OWNER) UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF PARTS A AND C OF CHAPTER 3 OF THE TOWN PLANNING AND TOWNSHIPS ORDINANCE, 1986 (ORDINANCE 15 OF 1986), FOR PERMISSION TO ESTABLISH A TOWNSHIP ON PORTION 606 OF THE FARM RIETFONTEIN 31, REGISTRATION DIVISION I.R., PROVINCE OF GAUTENG HAS BEEN GRANTED

A. CONDITIONS OF ESTABLISHMENT

- (1) **NAME**
The name of the township shall be Bredell Extension 20.
- (2) **DESIGN**
The township shall consist of erven and streets as indicated on Plan SG No. 32/2014.
- (3) **DISPOSAL OF EXISTING CONDITIONS OF TITLE**
All erven shall be made subject to existing conditions and servitudes, if any, excluding the following servitudes which do not affect the township due to its locality:
 - (a) The portion of the farm RIETFONTEIN 18, district BENONI, of which the above property forms a part, is subject to the following

- (4) ACCESS
Access to the township shall be obtained from Sixth Road.
- (5) ENGINEERING SERVICES
 - (i) The applicant shall be responsible for the installation and provision of internal engineering services.
 - (ii) Once water, sewer and electrical networks have been installed, same will be transferred to the Local Council, free of cost, who shall maintain these networks.
- (6) DEMOLITION OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES
The township owner shall at his own expense cause all existing buildings and structures situated within the building line reserves, side spaces or over common boundaries to be demolished to the satisfaction of the local authority, when required by the local authority to do so.
- (7) ACCEPTANCE AND DISPOSAL OF STORMWATER
The township owner shall arrange for the drainage of the township to fit in with that of the existing and planned road and storm water infrastructure in the vicinity and for all storm water running off or diverted from the roads to be received and disposed of.
- (8) REMOVAL OF LITTER
The township owner shall at his own expense cause all litter within the township area to be removed to the satisfaction of the local authority when required by the local authority to do so.
- (9) PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES
The township owners shall at his own expense, make arrangements with the local authority in order to ensure that:
 - (i) Water will not dam up, that the entire surface of the township area is drained properly and that streets are sealed effectively with tar, cement or bitumen; and
 - (ii) The recommendations as laid down in the geological report / soil report of the township are complied with and when required engineer certificates for the foundations of the structures are submitted.
- (10) REPOSITIONING OF SERVICES
I, by reason of the establishment of the township, it should become necessary to reposition any existing services of ESKOM, Telkom or the local authority, the cost thereof shall be borne by the township owners.
- (11) CONSOLIDATION OF ERVEN
The township owner shall at his own expense cause Erven 150 and 151 in the township to be consolidated.

B. CONDITIONS OF TITLE

ALL ERVEN SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS IMPOSED BY THE LOCAL AUTHORITY IN TERMS OF THE PROVISIONS OF THE TOWN PLANNING AND TOWNSHIPS ORDINANCE, 1986.

(a) ALL ERVEN

- (i) The erf is subject to a servitude, 2m wide, in favour of the local authority, for sewerage and other municipal purposes, along any two boundaries other than a street boundary and in the case of a panhandle erf, an additional servitude for municipal purposes 2m wide across the access portion of the erf, if and when required by the local authority: Provided that the local authority may dispense with any such servitude.
- (ii) No building or other structure shall be erected within the aforesaid servitude area and no large-rooted trees shall be planted within the area of such servitude or within 2m thereof.

- (iii) The local authority shall be entitled to deposit temporarily on the land adjoining the aforesaid servitude such material as may be excavated by it during the course of the construction, maintenance or removal of such sewerage mains and other works as it, in its discretion may deem necessary and shall further be entitled to reasonable access to the said land for the aforesaid purpose subject to any damage done during the process of the construction, maintenance or removal of such sewerage mains and other works being made good by the local authority.
