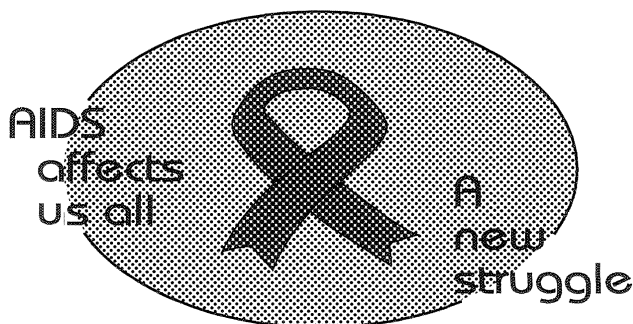

NOTICE 156 OF 2015

Limpopo Provincial Government
Department of Transport

Notice in terms of section 23 and 24 of the National Land Transport Act 2009 (Act No 5 OF 2009): Establishment of a Provincial Regulatory Entity and Disestablishment of the Provincial Operating Licensing Board.

1. By virtue of the powers vested in me in terms of sections 23 and 24 of the National Land Transport Act (Act 5 of 2009) I, Mapula Mokaba-Phukwana, Member of the Executive Council responsible for Transport, Safety, Security and Liaison hereby, with effect from 01 June 2015 -
 - a. establish the Limpopo Provincial Regulatory Entity;
 - b. transfer the functions of the Provincial Operating Licensing Board established in terms of the National Land Transport Transition Act, 2000 (Act 22 of 2000) to the Provincial Regulatory Entity; and
 - c. disestablish and dissolve the said Provincial Operating Licensing Board.

2. Any application to the said Provincial Operating Licensing Board relating to the granting, amendment, renewal or transfer of an operating licence which has not been disposed on or before 01 June 2015, is deemed to be an application to the said Provincial Regulatory Entity relating to the appropriate operating licence. All assets, rights, liabilities and obligations of the said Provincial Operating Licensing Board are transferred to and vest in the said Provincial Regulatory Entity, which is for all purposes the successor-in-law of the disestablished Operating Licensing Board.

Dear Valued Customers,

Government Printing Works has implemented rules for completing and submitting the electronic Adobe Forms when you, the customer, submits your notice request.

Please take note of these guidelines when completing your form.

GPW Business Rules

1. No hand written notices will be accepted for processing, this includes Adobe forms which have been completed by hand.
2. Notices can only be submitted in Adobe electronic form format to the email submission address submit.egazette@gpw.gov.za. This means that any notice submissions not on an Adobe electronic form that are submitted to this mailbox will be **rejected**. National or Provincial gazette notices, where the Z95 or Z95Prov must be an Adobe form but the notice content (body) will be an attachment.
3. Notices brought into GPW by "walk-in" customers on electronic media can only be submitted in Adobe electronic form format. This means that any notice submissions not on an Adobe electronic form that are submitted by the customer on electronic media will be **rejected**. National or Provincial gazette notices, where the Z95 or Z95Prov must be an Adobe form but the notice content (body) will be an attachment.
4. All customers who walk in to GPW that wish to submit a notice that is not on an electronic Adobe form will be routed to the Contact Centre where the customer will be taken through the completion of the form by a GPW representative. Where a customer walks into GPW with a stack of hard copy notices delivered by a messenger on behalf of a newspaper the messenger must be referred back to the sender as the submission does not adhere to the submission rules.
5. All notice submissions that do not comply with point 2 will be charged full price for the notice submission.
6. The current cut-off of all Gazette's remains unchanged for all channels. (Refer to the GPW website for submission deadlines – www.gpwnonline.co.za)
7. Incorrectly completed forms and notices submitted in the wrong format will be rejected to the customer to be corrected and resubmitted. Assistance will be available through the Contact Centre should help be required when completing the forms. (012-748 6200 or email info.egazette@gpw.gov.za)
8. All re-submissions by customers will be subject to the above cut-off times.
9. All submissions and re-submissions that miss the cut-off will be rejected to the customer to be submitted with a new publication date.
10. Information on forms will be taken as the primary source of the notice to be published. Any instructions that are on the email body or covering letter that contradicts the notice form content will be ignored.

You are therefore advised that effective from **Monday, 18 May 2015** should you not comply with our new rules of engagement, all notice requests will be rejected by our new system.

Furthermore, the fax number **012- 748 6030** will also be **discontinued** from this date and customers will only be able to submit notice requests through the email address submit.egazette@gpw.gov.za.
