


**DECLARATION OF PROVINCIAL STATE OF DISASTER: DISASTER
MANAGEMENT ACT, 2002 (ACT NO. 57 OF 2002)**

I, David Dabede Mabuza, hereby, in my capacity as Premier of the Mpumalanga Province, and after consultation with the other members of the Mpumalanga Executive Council declare, in terms of section 41(1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2002 (Act No. 57 of 2002), a Provincial state of disaster in the Nkomazi Local Municipality, Bushbuckridge Local Municipality, Mbombela Local Municipality, Umjindi Local Municipality, Mkhondo Local Municipality, Chief Albert Luthuli Local Municipality, Lekwa Local Municipality, Dr Pixley Ka Isaka Seme Local Municipality, Govan Mbeki Local Municipality, and Msukaligwa Local Municipality, with immediate effect.

I further authorize, in terms of section 41(2) of the Disaster Management Act, 2002, the Member of the Executive Council for Co-operative Governance and Traditional Affairs to issue directions in respect of the declared Provincial state of disaster, as and when necessary, as contemplated in section 41(2) of the said Act subject to section 41(3) thereof.
