NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CLOSE PERDEKOP AGRICULTURAL SCHOOL

By virtue of the power vested in me in terms of Section (33)1)(a)(b)(c)and(d) of the South African Schools Act (Act 84 of 1996) I, Makgabo Reginah Mhaule, being Member of the Executive Council responsible for Mpumalanga Department of Education, hereby publish a notice of intention to close Perdekop Agricultural School EMIS NO 800017996 located in the Gert Sibande District with effect from the end of the school calendar year 2014. The school buildings and premises will be utilized for the establishment of an FET College site under Gert Sibande FET College.

In compliance with the provision of section 33(3) of the Act, all assets and liabilities of the school shall from the date of the closure of the school, be transferred to Gert Sibande FET College.

The Perdekop Agricultural School will enrol the last intake of grade 8 learners in 2014 for the 2015 academic year and phase out all grades from 2015 to 2019 as the college phases in from 2015. Proper consultations will be done with labour unions and staff of the school for the management of the transfer of staff in line with section 197 of the Labour Relations Act
