PROCLAMATION

By His Royal Highness the High Commissioner.

Whereas it is expedient to make provision to enable additional officers of the Basutoland Government to administer oaths and take affidavits or solemn declarations in all cases where the same may be lawfully administered or taken.

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section one of Proclamation No. 2b of 1884 headed "Oaths, Affidavits, etc." shall be and is hereby amended by the addition after the words "Resident Commissioner" of the words "Deputy-Resident Commissioner, Government Secretary, Financial Secretary, Chief Clerk Master and Registrar of the Resident Commissioner's Court, Accountant" and by the addition after the words "within the territory" of the following:—

"and such other persons within the territory as the High Commissioner may from time to time appoint by notice in the *Gazette*."

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Basutoland Administration of Oaths Proclamation 1923 and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
