**REVISED TIMELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF INFORMATION IN REGARD TO
MOBILE BROADBAND SERVICES INQUIRY**

The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") has recently published a notice, together with a questionnaire, (Government Gazette No. 42044) of intention to conduct an inquiry into mobile broadband services in terms of section 4B of the Independent Communications Authority of South Africa Act. 13 of 2000, read with section 67(4) of the Electronic Communications Act No. 36 of 2000.

In response to a request for extended timelines the Authority has now granted a submission extension to stakeholders from 11 March 2019 to 29 March 2019.
